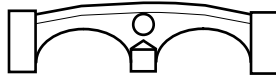


MAISEMORE PARISH COUNCIL



The minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Wednesday 16th January 2019 at 7.30pm in Maisemore Village Hall.

Present Cllrs Carole Banks, Debbie Burgess, Andrew Cooley (Chairman), Robert Scott and Peter Wegmann.

In Attendance 48 members of the public.

1. Apologies for Absence.

Apologies were received from the clerk. The Council agreed that Pippa Cooley would take notes for the minutes.

2. Declaration of Interests.

There were none.

The meeting was closed to allow public participation for members of the public to give their views on the application to build an intensive poultry unit to the north of the village - application 18/01162/FUL

Members of the public raised various issues on the application, in no particular order, of objection to the proposal, including inappropriate development, loss of amenity, air, water, light and noise pollution, bio-security, highway safety, absence of continuous supervision on site, economic impact and flaws in the application and associated documents.

The chairman asked for a show of hands in for and against the application, there were 2 in favour, both being associated with the applicant, and 46 against.

The meeting was resumed.

To Discuss Planning Application No. 18/01162/FUL - erection of two poultry rearing buildings with ancillary development on land east of the A417 at Overton, Maisemore.

The council voted unanimously to object to the application. Cllr Cooley agreed to prepare a representation to Tewkesbury Borough Council which would be circulated to members and, when agreed, put on the Maisemore Parish Council website.
