The minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Wednesday 23rd January 2019 at 7.30pm in Maisemore Village Hall.

1. Apologies for Absence.

None received.

2. Declaration of Interests.

Cllr Robert Scott declared an ODI in item 3, he remained in the room for the public participation but took no part in the discussion or decision.

The meeting was closed to allow public participation.

Mr Luke Chamberlayne outlined his proposal to the meeting and answered question.

Members of the public raised various issues, in no particular order, of objection to the proposal, parking, sewage, length of time of build, type of build, diversion of footpath, lack of village services and adverse effect on the village hall, exit on to the A419 and visual impact.

Members of the public raised various issues, in no particular order, of support to the proposal, a need for affordable houses in the village and employment for local trade's people.

The chairman asked for a show of hands in favour of the application, the number being 12, it was noted that most of these where not parishioners and the number against was 27, all being parishioners.

The meeting was resumed.

3. To Discuss Planning Application No. 18/01202/OUT - Part Parcel 3538 Church Road Maisemore.

The council took a vote three in favour of objecting and one for accepting. At this point Cllr Cooley stated that he couldn't be involved in the Council's representation as he had voted for support. He handed the chair over to Cllr Burgess and left the meeting. The council then discussed the reasons for objecting.
